# **Definitions**

DH

Critical Conservation Areas Outside Reserves: These are areas of relatively undisturbed habitat containing diverse, productive, representative or endangered fauna and/or flora communities. They are very high priority conservation areas that are essential to the maintenance of biodiversity in the region and are deserving of protected area status.

Major Environmental Corridors:

These are significant regional-scale corridors that should be preserved to maintain linkages between habitat areas and facilitate the movement of fauna. They are generally based on existing natural features such as rivers, creeks or ridges and the associated remnant vegetation, but can also incorporate cleared or partially cleared areas that may be suitable for future rehabilitation.

Major Industry:

Major Industry areas identify large areas intended to accommodate a wide range of industrial and related business activities including manufacturing, processing and storage/distribution uses. Land within major industry areas should not be used for residential or other purposes that are incompatible with these primary activities.

**Region:** See Townsville–Thuringowa

Regional Centre: The Regional Centre is the main commercial, administrative, social, cultural and

recreational centre for the region. The Townsville CBD fulfils this role, and is the preferred location for higher order commercial and administrative activities, short-stay tourist and business accommodation, and entertainment, recreational and

cultural activities with a regional focus.

Rural/Non Urban: The Rural/Non Urban areas designate the balance areas of the region which are

intended to be used predominantly for rural purposes or retained in their natural state. Uses with special locational requirements or which cannot be appropriately accommodated in other designated areas may also be located in the Rural/Non

Urban area.

**Rural Residential:** Rural residential areas comprise large lots used primarily for residential purposes.

Lots are generally larger than 2,000m<sup>2</sup> but significantly smaller than required for

rural economic activities common to the area.

Special Uses: Special use areas identify land used for significant community facilities or other

public purposes such as defence installations, major communications facilities,

universities, airports and major hospitals.

**Sub-Regional Centres:** A sub-regional centre provides a range of retail, commercial, community and

recreational facilities sufficient to meet the needs of a population catchment of around 50,000+ people. They are also the major employment and activity nodes outside the CBD. The three existing Sub-Regional Centres are located at Aitkenvale, Hyde Park and Thuringowa Central. New sub-regional centres are proposed for Burdell–Mt Low and Rocky Springs as required to meet the needs of these future

urban growth areas.

**Townships:** Townships are small communities with a limited population (generally less than

1,000 people) and a limited range of facilities and services.

Townsville-Thuringowa: The region comprising the Local Government areas of Townsville and Thuringowa.

**Urban Areas:** Urban areas are where most members of the regional community live, work and

recreate. They comprise residential areas together with a wide range of other areas and activities required to serve the community including environmental areas, parklands and sporting fields, district and neighbourhood centres and local shops, small and medium scale business and industry areas, schools and other institutional

uses.
